What is Didactic Sequence?

According to Zabala (1998), the Didactic Sequence is defined as "a set of ordered, structured and articulated activities for the realization of certain educational objectives, which have a beginning and an end known both by teachers and students".

The didactic sequence, characterized as a teaching strategy, mediated by a teacher, consists of a sequence of different activities that may include reading, individual or collective research, dialogue classes, textual productions, practical classes, computer simulations, experiments, etc. This approach over a set of meetings enables the acquisition and construction of knowledge through meaningful learning, making it possible to achieve educational objectives.
